TERM 1 AQUATICS

Aquatics is a scheduled part of the school curriculum in term 1. We are lucky to have a pool on site and during these warm months each class has at least 3 swimming sessions timetabled per week.

Aquatics should be regarded as being as important as any other aspect of the Physical Education programme. It gives students skills and confidence in and around water, develops stamina and builds strength.

We expect all students to swim with their class group this term. Please send your child/ren to school prepared for swimming with named swimwear and a named towel in a bag. For hygiene reasons children should not wear their togs under their clothes to school.

Even if the weather looks unpleasant in the morning, send them with their togs anyway. If you are unsure which days your child has swimming please ask their teacher or your child.

If your child does not come to school prepared to swim, and we have not been notified by you, we will be sending home a blue non-participation note.

If your child has an acute medical reason why they mustn't swim please contact the class teacher in person or by email or note to explain the reason.

In addition to the regular class swimming sessions we are fortunate to have a team from Fulton Swimming who will be taking our middle school students for water skills lessons. If your child is in year 3,4,5 or 6 they will have aquatic sessions every Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday from 10 February - 2 March.

FUNDRAISING

- ⇒ Our senior students will be selling ice-blocks (\$1 each) every Monday - Thursday during term 1 as part of their camp fundraising. Your teacher will take the money for these in the morning and you will receive your ice block at lunch time.
- ⇒ Every Friday we alternate between the PTA selling pizzas and the school selling Pies & Sausage Rolls. Tomorrow we will be selling Pies and Sausage Rolls for \$2 ea, Ice Blocks \$1 and Oat Bars for 50 cents.
